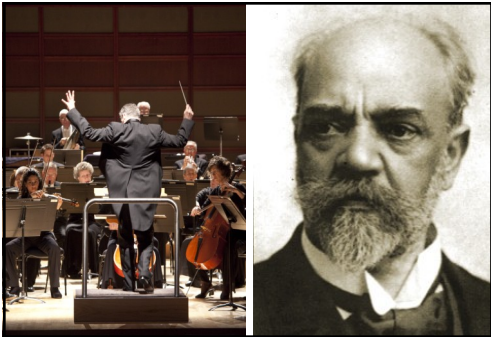


Breakfast & N.C. Symphony

Refund Policy :

1. Full refund for trips cancelled or adjusted by APR&CR. (Does not include modifications.)
2. If a refund is requested, in writing, prior to the registration deadline, a full refund minus a \$5.00 processing fee will be made.
3. If a refund is requested, in writing, after the registration deadline, and 48 hours prior to trip departure, a 75% refund will be issued if the participant can be replaced from the waiting list.
4. If 48 hours prior to the trip departure, a written excuse from a licensed medical doctor is provided, indicating that the participant should not participate due to medical concerns or physical limitations, a partial refund will be issued after deducting any expenses incurred by the Town of Apex / APR&CR such as prepaid admission fees, tickets, deposits, and a \$5.00 processing fee.
5. Because non-refundable deposits and admission fees may be required in advance, they cannot be refunded after the registration deadline.

Located in Wilmington, Poplar Grove Plantation is one of the oldest existing peanut plantations in North Carolina. Purchased in 1795 and held within the Foy Family until the mid 1970's, Poplar Grove is a sprawling homestead that has been well-preserved. We will take a tour of the plantation including the restored 1850 manor house.

We'll also attend the Annual Herb and Garden Fair marking the beginning of spring. Gain knowledge and inspiration on many diverse topics such as vegetable gardening, flower arranging, composting and cooking. The plant sale will feature a huge selection of annuals, perennials, nature art, hanging baskets and more!

The North Carolina Zoo is one of the state's most prized treasures. Located just south of Asheboro, the North Carolina Zoo is seated on a 1,500-acre tract of land in the Uwharrie Mountains. Approximately 500 acres of this property have been developed into one of the largest "natural habitat" zoos in the United States. After a special presentation by the education staff you'll spend the day touring the zoo on your own. Lunch will be in the zoo at the various restaurants and cafés.

Registration Information:

Nonresidents will register two weeks after Apex residents. Please see each trip for registration start dates and registration deadlines. On the first day of registration, promptly at 9am, those in line will participate in the lottery if there are more people in line than there are spaces available. Patrons will draw a number and line up according to their number. Everyone arriving after 9am will go to the back of the line.

Departure & Arrival Site:

Apex Community Center parking lot located at 53 Hunter Street unless otherwise noted on specific trip itinerary. Arrive 15-30 minutes early.

Transportation:

We will travel via charter motor coach, a 15 passenger van or by meeting at the designated location. Mode of travel is noted by trip.

Payment:

Payment and signed registration form must be collected to register for a trip and must be made by the registration deadlines. Space is limited.

Trip Notes:

- The bus will leave promptly at the departure time stated for each trip.
- Please dress appropriately and wear comfortable shoes.
- Occasionally, unforeseen circumstances or events beyond our control may occur before or during a trip, resulting in modification of trip itineraries.
- You are responsible for purchase of your own meals, snacks and any applicable fees unless otherwise noted. Please see notes regarding breakfast/lunch/dinner stops.
